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Dear Parents/Carers,

As you may be aware, throughout the school we use a behaviour system called 'Going for Gold'. This is a successful system for the older children as they use it to celebrate their successes and as an opportunity for reflection when things need to be improved. Each half term parents receive a letter letting them know how their child has behaved at school.

In Nursery and Reception, the children are not yet at an age where they would understand this system fully. The children are just starting their school journey with us and are learning about our school expectations in an age appropriate way. 'Personal, Social and Emotional Development' is a big part of our curriculum and we spend lots of time talking to the children about making good choices and following 'The Heart of Sacred Heart'. At times, we may talk to the children about the 'Going for Gold' system in preparation for when they enter Year 1.
