Hand Creams and Hand Gels

Dear Parent/Carers,

It has come to our attention that a few children are bringing in their own hand gels and hand creams to school. Although they are predominantly safe to use, any substance brought into school needs to be assessed. As a school we have plenty of hand sanitiser gel in classrooms and also regular hand washing routines happen throughout the day. Therefore the need to bring in hand gels and creams from home is not necessary.

We understand in a small number of cases some children may have sensitive skin or allergies to certain products. If this is the case you need to call the school office to discuss this in more detail before bringing in the hand gel or cream into school. We would need to check ingredients as they may contain ingredients that other children may be allergic to.

If the cream is prescribed then you will need to fill in the medical paperwork so that this can be administered in school.

Thank you for your support and cooperation in this matter to ensure that all children are safe.
