Dear Parents/Carers.

Year 3 – Southend Museum

At the start of the summer term, year 3 will be studying the Roman Empire and the Roman invasion of Britain. In order for the children to gain a wider understanding of Roman life in Britain, we will be visiting Southend Museum to explore their new exhibition of Roman life in Southend.

St Clare Class will be visiting the museum on Wednesday 24th April and St Francis Class will be vising the museum on Friday 26th April. The session will run between 11am and 2pm and will allow the children to explore Roman artefacts that have been collected from across South Essex (many of which are being displayed publicly for the first time). This visit will allow children to build upon their understanding of the Roman Empire and how this affected life in Britain.

All children will need to have a bag (preferably a rucksack containing their packed lunch and water to carry on their backs). Pupils who receive free school meals may request a school packed lunch if required.

Children should wear uniforms, but please can your child come prepared for the weather that day, i.e, waterproof coat. As we will be walking to the museum, please ensure pupils have sensible footwear (i.e. trainers).

The cost of the trip will be £6.50 per pupil. This should be paid through School Money, by Monday 22nd April. Please also indicate that you give permission for your child to accompany us to the Museum.

Should insufficient funds be raised to cover the cost of the trip, the trip will have to be cancelled. Please also be aware that any child without parental permission will not be allowed to travel. regardless of whether payment has been received.

This trip will prove an excellent experience for the children.
