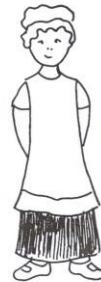
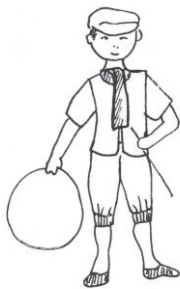
Dear parents/carers,

- A white apron could also be worn.
- A mob cap or a hat and a shawl would complete the look.
